HEARING FROM HEAVEN

I'd like to tell you a story of a recent revelation of transformation.

I've been in ministry forty-seven years. A year and a half ago, the Holy Spirit rocked my world. I was sharing at a business workshop, and I invited a young couple to come and share with my wife and I. They have an amazing business testimony. This was a bilingual church, Spanish and English.

I was sharing on the topic of our Heavenly Father's love, and how our hearts work. How we tend to build a wall around our hearts, how we add a brick to the wall every time we get hurt. And by the time we are twenty, thirty or forty, we have built a pretty high wall to protect ourselves from being hurt again (also, see John Eldredge's book, *The Sacred Romance*). What I've discovered was, that wall blocks out the love of our Heavenly Father also.

As we were sharing that day, the couple, Ken and Teena Starr, got up and shared their testimonies on business, marriage and their walk with God.



As we were wrapping up, we invited people up for prayer. Now, something special that Ken and Teena taught me, is what I affectionately termed, the “holy hug”. Ken would go up and hug somebody and hold them. Then speak the words that their Heavenly Father would say to them.

The key to the holy hug is to usher in Abba’s love through asking for forgiveness as their earthly father or mother, for the pain the parent (s) may have caused the son or daughter in the form of rejection, abandonment, abuse, neglect and/or other kinds of hurt. Here we are relying on the Holy Spirit to give Words of Knowledge, Wisdom and Prophecy and asking for forgiveness for not loving them the way they needed.

Teena and my wife were hugging and praying on the other side of the room with the women while Ken and I were with the men.



An amazing thing began to happen, the men and women weren't just crying, they began to weep and wail. And as they were being held, it was just the most

incredible outpouring of the Holy Spirit that I've been part of! Then Ken would turn them to me and say, "Go get a hug from Papa George". I would do the same thing, hug them, and prophesy or speak words their heavenly Father would speak to them. We literally had to lay many people down on the ground as they were experiencing His love.

What was happening through that holy hug, and those words of affirmation, caused people to have that wall around their hearts come down. And maybe for the first time, they were tangibly feeling the love of our Heavenly Father. The prayer time went on for a couple hours. It was so powerful.



A month later Ken and Teena were speaking at a Youth With A Mission (YWAM) training facility in Kona, Hawaii. They asked my wife and I if we would join them for three days ministering to thirty-five young people. The same outpouring of the Holy Spirit through "holy hugs" happened there. As we were sharing on the Father's love and giving holy hugs, the young people were weeping. I felt the love of the Father as well. Powerful.

On the second day, Tuesday, I was first to speak. Then we took a ten-minute break. I went out to look over the edge of the balcony where we were looking at Kona Bay. It's beautiful in downtown Kona. A young woman about twenty, Brittany, came over to talk to me. As I turned around and saw her she said to me, "Thank you for what you shared yesterday and today so far. I really appreciate it." I said, "thank you." There was an awkward pause and I felt that she wanted a hug. So, I asked, "May I give you a hug?" She said, "yes please." As I hugged her I was speaking the words her heavenly Father might say to her. She broke down

weeping and two women came over to hold her up. We all had an experience in God in that moment.



I got up a little bit later. It took Brittany some time to regain her composure. As she did, I asked if she would share what she was experiencing. As she shared the love of Father, she was tangibly feeling, you could just feel the Holy Spirit hit all of us. It was an amazing moment.



We then flew to Kauai where Ken and Teena have a home. They own businesses there and on Oahu. The employees from the company came over to their home and the Holy Spirit moved through “hugs” and prayer here also.

On Sunday the pastor of the church they support asked if I would share. I shared on the love of the Father and invited people for prayer. The Holy Spirit moved in a similar way there also. It seemed like everywhere we went, the Holy Spirit showed up with the outpouring of His love.



After the service that day my wife and I went out to the north end of the island where we had lunch. After lunch, we strolled into a Hawaiian dress shop. There were two ladies there, perhaps seventy years old.

I introduced my wife and I and stated that, "I would like you to dress my wife like a Hawaiian queen". One of the women was the owner, Lorre. She got all excited and started buzzing around the store trying to find the right Hawaiian dresses for Randi, my wife.

As my wife was trying on the dresses, the Holy Spirit spoke to me and prompted me to think, "Lorre doesn't know how much I love her."

So, I just turned to Lorre and said, "Lorre, you don't know how much your heavenly Father loves you." She just stared at me. And I said, "May I give you a hug?" She said, "Yes" so I gave her a hug.



My wife came out of the dressing room, and Lorre just starts fluttering around the store again, and said, "Oh, you need to try this on. You need to try that on."

Her helper, Sandy was watching all of this. I'm standing right next to Sandy, just a little counter between us. And I got an inspiration. So, I said, "Sandy, I know why your name is Sandy." She said, "You do?" I said, "Yes, there's an ancient writing that says, 'as the stars are of the heavens, and the sands are of the sea, so are my thoughts towards you, says the Lord'". I'm staring at her, eye to eye as I'm saying this. She just started weeping. She came around the counter and she asked, "Could I give you a hug". We got to have a "holy hug". I'm speaking the words her Heavenly Father would say to her, and how valued she is, how much he loves her, and that she has a divine destiny in God. And she just held on to me, it was about five minutes. We were both saturating in the Father's love.



We had just a marvelous time together. They were so grateful and so gracious to us. When we left, my wife and I got in the car, we looked at each other and said, “What just happened?” Wow!

THE HEART REVELATION



When we came back from Hawaii, I felt like the Lord gave me a download. It was as if He condensed down if all sixty-six books of the Bible to this one sentence, ***I am designed to receive my Father's love and to pour it out, back on Him and on my sphere of influence.*** It's as if, I am the “hose of heaven”.

ACT 1

You see God designed each one of us with a love tank and He wants to pour his love into our love tank. We can then pour it out back on Him and others.

Oh my gosh, that was such a great revelation for me! I think it well covers the great commandment, to love God with all your heart, soul, strength and mind and to love your neighbor as yourself.

Now I understand that I am designed to run on “Supreme” fuel. Yet all these years I’ve been filling my love tank with something other than His love.



I’ve been “looking for love in all the wrong places”. I’ve been filling my love tank with things that God never designed for me to fill it with, whether it be sinful pleasures, distractions of work or self-righteousness. The problem is, every time I fill my own love tank with something other than the Father’s love, I’m hungry again in an hour! And... I feel guilty because, I know that wasn’t the right “fuel”.

From that revelation, the next thing the Lord gave me was my **capacity**. How can I increase? How can I get more of MY Father’s love, and therefore pour out more of His love? I saw a picture in my mind of a drinking straw. A drinking straw has a certain capacity, right? Well, then there's the garden hose, that has more capacity. And then we have a fire hose, even more capacity. And then finally, a pipeline, even greater capacity.



Our Father wants to increase His love flowing in us and out of us.

I believe what the Holy Spirit's doing in the earth today is pouring out the new wine that He saved up for this end time. I believe the new wine is the Father's love, not just knowing about it, but having a tangible experience with it, where I am literally feeling the Father's love.

What can I do to participate with heaven for increase of capacity? What “things” are blocking or keeping me from receiving more of my heavenly Father’s love?



Five things that I call, ***The Process*** are ways I can participate with heaven to increase capacity of receiving His love.



1. **REVELATION.** I need to see me the way my Father sees me. I need to understand that my Heavenly Father wants to do something in me, to change me from glory to glory, to bring increase in capacity. And so, what are the things that are blocking the increase from coming into me? That's what he wants to show me. Once I get revelation of what He wants to do in me then I see the next step.
2. **RESTORATION.** He wants to restore me to my Father. Jesus said, "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No man comes unto the Father but by Me". See John 14:6.

Jesus came to reveal the Father. And that's what's happening now by the power of the Holy Spirit. Today, the Holy Spirit is revealing the Father and His love. Around the world, people are experiencing an intimate experience of His love. The Father's love is the New Wine Jesus spoke of that He is saving for this end time. You can't put new wine in an old wine skin. See Matthew 9:17.

Jesus came to forgive my sins and therefore restore me back into relationship with the Father like Adam and Eve had in the garden of Eden.



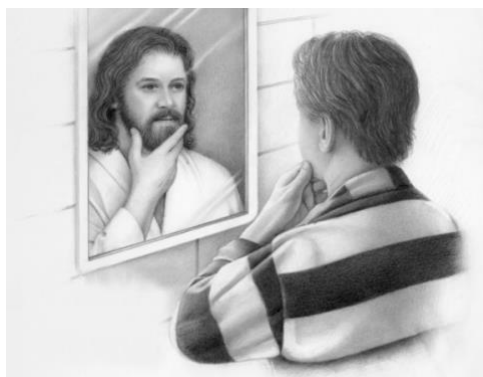
3. **HEALING.** Part of life is going through challenges, hardships and pain. Often there are traumas, scars, wounds and injustices that happened in life. These are areas that are keeping me from receiving more love. Our Father wants to heal those areas. Therefore, I want to find a good Christian counselor that can help me process healing in those areas so I can receive more of my Father's love.
4. The healing prayer or **DELIVERANCE** ministry. And that is just simply this, where have I come into agreement with the enemy about anything?

Oftentimes, I'm in agreement with the enemy about my vision of myself. Or, I have a wrong vision of my heavenly Father. Or, I have wrong thinking about family or friends. I want to break any agreements that I have with the enemy and thereby experience the freedom that comes in the promises of God.

Galatians 5:1 says, "Stand fast therefore in the liberty, by which Christ has made you free."

You see saints, God wants us to be free. If I don't have the influence that the enemy used to hold over me, I can receive more of His love.

5. **IDENTITY.** My identity comes from my Father.



Who does my Father say I am? How does He see me?

Wisdom would suggest that I need to put effort into finding out who He says I am and to discover how He sees me. Certainly, there are teachings on this subject of Identity.

We suggest you check out the ***Identity Project at Academy.KingdomLiving.global***.

Part of my identity is knowing through experience His love for me. To know that we are loved, highly prized and delighted in, is what we all long for. I have made a quality decision that I am who my Father says I am. Period. Now I need to discover who He says I am. When I understand the new creation God shaped with me, my bad behavior will no longer define me. Now I am no longer a sinner. I am a 100% redeemed saint that does sometimes sin. My identity is of a saint now or a "new creation." More on this topic later.

ACT 2

THE BOOKENDS



The Father showed me a pair of bookends.

One bookend was, ***“There is nothing I can do to increase His love for me.”*** Wow. When I got that revelation, it showed me His unconditional love! You mean I don't have to do anything to get all of your love or to increase your love for me?

I don't have to **do** to get more of His love? I don't have to be a pastor. I don't have to do all these good things. I can just sit around and do nothing? Yep. The Father loves me and I can't increase his love for me. He already loves me to the moon and back. He wants me to know that. That is one bookend.

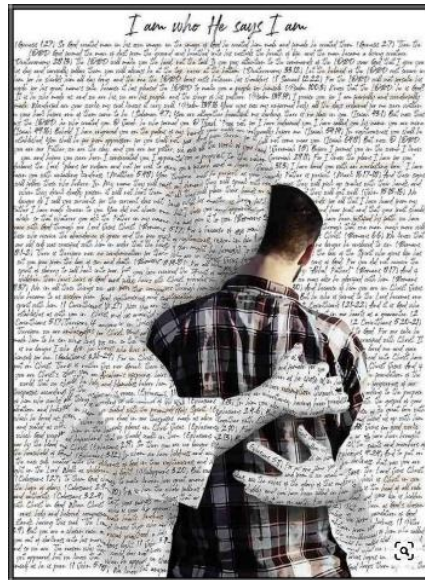
The other bookend is, ***“There is nothing I can do to cause my Father to love me less.”***

Have you ever thought of that?

My bad behavior doesn't cause Him to love me less? He can't love me more. He can't love me less. Wow. I want to walk in that revelation.

Let's be clear here. My good or bad behavior doesn't have any effect on His love for me. Yet certainly my behavior affects the blessings or trials I experience. My bad behavior no longer defines me.

I have made a quality decision that ***I am who my Father says I am***. Period. Now, who does he say I am? He says I am his beloved son or daughter.



You know what heals my heart? To hear the same words that Jesus heard when he was baptized. "George, you are My beloved son, in whom I'm well pleased." Don't we all yearn to hear that?

First, I am His Beloved. He loves me as much as He loves Jesus. I am loved!
Second, I am his son. I'm part of the family of God. My older brother is Jesus. I'm not an orphan. Why am I acting like an orphan? Why am I trying to make my own way in life? I can go to my Father to get what I need. Because I'm his beloved. I am his son.

Finally, He delights in me!



Come on!!! To have your Father delight in you? It is the passion of our hearts. Isn't that what we cry out for? To hear Him say, "I'm proud of you. I just love watching you growing up and you can't do anything wrong in my eyes. You are my delight." You see, that's what He says. That's what He wants us to know, in our hearts, by experience not just book knowledge.

ACT 3

THE PRODIGAL BROTHERS

Then He (Jesus) said: "A certain man had two sons.

"And the younger of them said to his father, 'Father, give me the portion of goods that falls to me.' So, he divided to them his livelihood. And not many days after, the younger son gathered all together, journeyed to a far country, and there wasted his possessions with prodigal living. "But when he had spent all, there arose a severe famine in that land, and he began to be in want.

"Then he went and joined himself to a citizen of that country, and he sent him into his fields to feed swine. And he would gladly have filled his stomach with the pods that the swine ate, and no one gave him anything. But when he came to himself, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!

'I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you and I am no longer worthy to be called your son. Make me like one of your hired servants.

And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him.

And the son said to him,

'Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight, and am no longer worthy to be called your son.

But the father said to his servants,

'Bring out the best robe and put it on him and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet.

*And bring the fatted calf here and kill it and let us eat and be merry;
'for this my son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.'*

And they began to be merry.

"Now his older son was in the field. And as he came and drew near to the house, he heard music and dancing, so he called one of the servants and asked what these things meant.

*And he said to him,
'Your brother has come, and because he has received him safe and sound, your father has killed
the fatted calf.'*

*But he was angry and would not go in.
Therefore, his father came out and pleaded with him.*

*"So, he answered and said to his father,
'Lo, these many years I have been serving you;
I never transgressed your commandment at any time; and yet you never gave me a young goat,
that I might make merry with my friends.
'But as soon as this son of yours came, who has devoured your livelihood with harlots, you
killed the fatted calf for him.'*

*"And he said to him, 'Son, you are always with me, and all that I have is yours.
'It was right that we should make merry and be glad, for your brother was dead and is alive
again, and was lost and is found.'"*

Luke 15:11-32 NKJV



The young son takes the money and runs, right? You've got the older son that stays and is doing his father's business. He kind of represents the Pharisees. Keeping the law, doing everything right. But his heart is wrong.

Then, the young son repents and comes home. The loving, good father is so happy he throws a party.

Here's my question.

Both sons had a heart problem, didn't they? One took the money and ran. The other ran the father's business and was full of judgment. Why couldn't they receive their Father's love?

When this story takes place the brothers must have been in their twenties. They experienced the love of their good father all those years yet they both ended up with the same problem but manifested it differently. What was the problem they both had?

A hard or broken heart. One renounced his father and took his inheritance. The other “appeared” honorable and obedient and yet displayed a hard heart.



Why couldn't they receive their father's love in all the years they grew up in the good father's house? That was my question.

Not all of us have had bad fathers. Many of us have had a good father like the father in this story. And yet, many of us with good fathers have still “gone astray”. Being a good and loving earthly father does not guarantee loving, kind and obedient children.

Why the two sons, for twenty years, could not receive their father's love? For nine months I thought about this one question.

BACK TO THE GARDEN



Here is what I got, after nine months, when the baby of Revelation came. The Lord said to me, “We need to go back to the garden of Eden and find out what happened there.

God, Adam and Eve, walk together in the cool of the day. See Genesis 3:8

They're having a great time. And then the Father just says, “Hey, listen, there's two trees in the garden.

There's Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil, I don't want you to even know about good and evil. I just want you to know and eat from the Tree of Life, because I am the Tree of Life.

I just want you to partake of Me.

I am love and that's what you get from the Tree of Life. That's all you need. “

The Father gave Adam and Eve free will. The reason the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil was in the garden was to allow them to choose.

Without free choice there is no love.

Satan comes along to bring deception. Well, before we get into the rest of the story, we need to understand who satan was? Where did he come?

When we study scripture, we find out that Satan was Lucifer in heaven before time.

Lucifer was probably the worship leader among the angels and perhaps the most beautiful.



Our heavenly Father ruled over all His creation including the angels. Lucifer “was perfect until iniquity was found in him.”

What was that iniquity?

Lucifer, in essence, didn’t want **a Father over him**, Lucifer wanted **to BE** the Father. Lucifer didn’t want to serve God, he wanted to be God.

And God our Father said, “I don't think so.” God cast Lucifer to the earth along with perhaps a third of the angels that followed Lucifer.

So, Lucifer becomes satan (adversary, opponent) and is now in the earth.

Lucifer now satan has become “the ultimate orphan” if you will, because he rejected, opposed his Father. So now, Satan wants to make everybody like himself, an orphan, fatherless!

Satan deceives Eve with “So, of course, God doesn't want you to eat off the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, because then you'll be just like Him.”



There was the temptation. They fell for it. They sinned.

When they sinned, they in effect, gave the keys of the kingdom, power and authority to rule and reign in the earth and have dominion and multiply, to satan.

When they chose to believe satan and not their heavenly Father, they were saying “We're going to trust now in what you say instead of our heavenly Father.”

And that is when their hearts got broken. They broke the relationship with their Heavenly Father.

They broke communion and intimacy with their heavenly Father. Adam and Eve became orphans just like satan.

Then Adam and Eve went out of the garden and had to live in an “abusive foster father's home.” The Father, in His love, set an angel to guard the entry to the Garden so they would not eat again off the Tree of Life and forever live in that broken hearted state.

Yet, the Father promised that He would send a Redeemer, to buy back mankind into restored intimate relationship with Himself. He would send the “second Adam” Jesus. But in the meantime, they lived like orphans. How does an orphan live? They might say, “If it’s meant to be, it’s up to me.” “I need to pull myself up by my own bootstraps.”

ACT 4

MADE IN HIS IMAGE

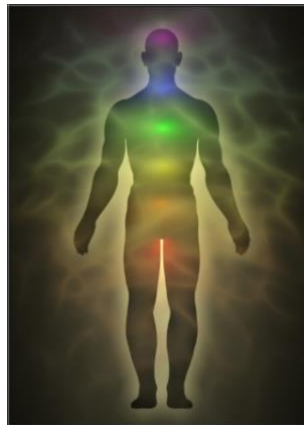
Now, how did God make Adam and Eve? What was their makeup?

Number one, they were **spirit**. God breathed life into the body He made from the earth, dirt (Adam means earth, dirt). And Adam “became a living being. See Genesis 2:7

And he made them to have a **soul**. Our soul is made up of our mind, will and emotions. See 1 Thessalonians 5:23

And He gave them an **earth suit** (fleshly body) to house their spirit and soul. He gave them an “earth suit” because He had an assignment, a purpose for them in the earth. That is why an evil spirit (fallen angel) needs a body (man or animal-See Mark 5:1-20) to wreak havoc in the earth. Alternatively, the evil spirit can convince a person to “do his bidding”.

Therefore, I am a spirit, I have a soul and I live in an earth suit.



When Adam and Eve were in the garden, walking with Father, they had everything they needed and more. They experienced the love of the Father. They abounded in His love.

When they left the garden because of believing a lie, the father of lies became their abusive adopted father. Their hearts were broken due to separation from their Heavenly Father.

But there was good news, the Father promised He'd send a Redeemer. Jesus, the second Adam (See 1 Corinthians 15:21-22), would restore His Beloved (those who receive Jesus as their Lord and Savior) back to the garden, back to right relationship with the Father and heal our wounded, separated hearts.

That is what I see about the Prodigal brothers; why they couldn't receive their earthly father's love. ***Because it was a spiritual problem***, they needed to be restored to their Heavenly Father, their spiritual Father.

I am a spirit, I have a soul and I live in an earth suit. Only their spiritual Father could bring healing to who they are, healing to their spirit.



For illustration, I am a spirit, and I have a soul (a mind, will and emotions).

I **am** a laptop, and I **have** software. I'm not the software, but I **have** software.

There is, of course, an intimate relationship between a laptop and software. It is important to dissect this a little bit, to really understand I am a spirit. And I have a soul. What I am is a spirit. And I have a mind, will and emotions.

When we can digest this distinction, we will no longer identify ourselves by our behavior?

Shame will no longer have a hold on us. Shame says, “not that I’ve made a mistake”, shame says “I am a mistake.” Because Jesus, the Father and Holy Spirit live in me, I can’t be a mistake! I may do wrong behavior because my soul is in

process of redemption, but who I am, my identity is Christ in me. My behavior no longer identifies me.

If we are born again and Jesus lives in me, my spirit, then I am “a new creation, old things have passed away and behold all things become new.” See 2 Corinthians 5:17 Sin then dwells in my soul not my spirit. See Romans 7:23

Who I really am then, is a one hundred percent redeemed spirit because Jesus, the Father and Holy Spirit live in my spirit. Now I am the tabernacle (house, dwelling place) of God!



Adam was a broken spirit, or unredeemed spirit when he left the garden .

No longer intimate with his heavenly Father, Adam’s broken heart (his spirit and soul) became what Romans 1:17-32 describes man apart from God, he is debased, a hater of God, vile, and every evil thing. That's the way he is, unredeemed man.

His soul (mind, will and emotions) starts to project something different than what his new reality is. If Adam were to show people who he now really was, they wouldn't want to be around him because he’s vile, evil, despicable and so on.

Adam is separated from his Heavenly Father, broken hearted. With his soul (his mind will and emotions) he begins to act things out. He is hiding the evil, carnal nature and pretending to be nice, kind, beautiful, etc... Because if people saw the way he really is now, they would run away from him. So, with his soul he practices being attractive. The soul is being deceptive, not really revealing his new self. His soul (mind, will and emotions) presents a different picture than the reality of his unredeemed, unregenerated spirit!

Before we get born again, before Jesus becomes the Lord of our lives, we are vile, ugly, selfish, unrighteous, wicked, covetous and so on. So, it's no wonder the ungodly portray themselves this way, appearing attractive when they are really ugly. Isn't Satan described as an angel of light? See 2 Corinthians 11:14

But when we become born again, Jesus, the Father and the Holy Spirit come to live in our spirit. Now our spirit is beautiful and fully redeemed, fully restored in right relationship to the Father. That which was lost in the Garden of Eden is now fully restored. The intimacy with our heavenly Father is now available because Jesus made the way, the second Adam (See 1 Corinthians 15:21-22) brought us back to the Garden.



The Bible calls the soul, the flesh or the carnal mind. Different authors on the Father's love have called the soul, the actor or the imposter. There's a couple of descriptors that I like, the soul is the hologram. Or how about an avatar? The soul has had much practice in portraying something that is not really there. An image, an illusion, not the reality.

The mind, will and emotions are trying to portray something that's different than it really is. And that's what we've learned to do in the flesh, before we accepted Christ as our Lord. But once Jesus becomes the Lord of our life, He comes to live and dwell in us. Now we become the tabernacle of God. Now we have a new identity, 2 Corinthians 5:17, "**Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.**"

Jesus, the Father and the Holy Spirit live in me now. My spirit becomes 100% redeemed. Do you see that I am (my spirit) a new creation, 100%?

I am restored to right relationship with my heavenly Father. It is Christ in me the hope of glory (Colossians 1:27). Now I don't need to hide my spirit man anymore. I need to be transparent and let the Christ in me be seen. My spirit is beautiful now because Jesus, the Father and Holy Spirit live in my spirit! I no longer need to practice hiding like the imposter, hologram or avatar!

Are my mind, will and emotions 100% redeemed?

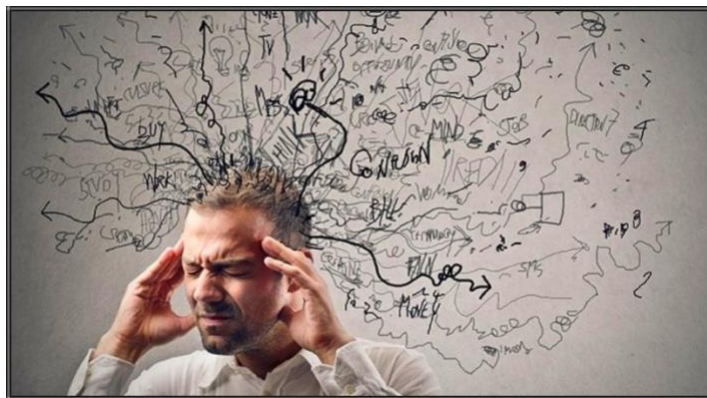
No, my soul is in the process of redemption. It is partially redeemed.

The church describes this state as sanctification. Our souls are in the process of being sanctified.

And if we are doing our spiritual work, we will see a growth of redemption in our souls.

When we say "growing in the spirit", what we're actually saying is, my soul (mind, will and emotions) is growing in greater redemption, sanctification.

"From glory to glory He is changing me." See 2 Corinthians 3:18



ACT 5

TIME TO GROW UP

Sons and daughters or mature children of God do spiritual work. This is my spiritual work, to bring the revelation from my spirit, into my soul.

I get revelation in my spirit, whether it's through the logos, or the rhema word. The logos is the written word. Rhema is the quickened word, as God speaking to you throughout the day. I need to bring the revelation I receive in my spirit, into my soul. This is our spiritual work.

THE COIN

How do I do that? Well, there are two scriptures and probably many more. I call it the coin, on one side is one scripture. And the other side is the other scripture. And that is Joshua 1:8, which I call the Law of Success.

“This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.”

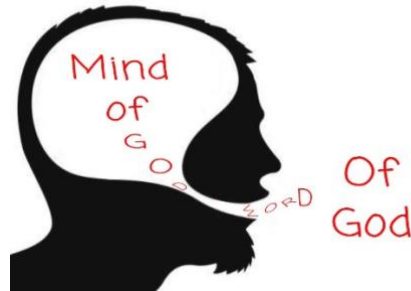
Here's the GLV (George La Du version) of the above scripture.

“Do not let the word of God stop coming out of your mouth. Chew on it, (meditate on it) day and night, like a cow chews its cud, then you'll know what the right thing to do is, then you'll make your way prosperous, and you'll have good success.”

The second (other side of the coin) scriptures is Romans 12:2 –

“And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”

These two scriptures are saying a similar thing. What we “chew on”, what we think on, dwell on makes a difference in what takes root in my soul. When the Word of God comes into my soul (my mind), it has the power to transform my soul into the likeness of my redeemed spirit. If I will practice “chewing” on the Word, my soul grows in redemption or grows in sanctification. “From glory to glory He is changing me!”



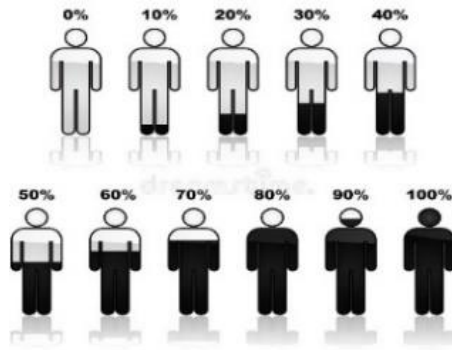
What is my spiritual work?

My spiritual work is to bring the Word of God from my spirit man into my mind, will and emotions. I chew on it, and that causes it to go from my thinking to the hard drive (my heart), if I will do this spiritual work.

Keeping with the computer analogy, the Word will go from the RAM to the hard drive. When it “gets to the hard drive” (the heart), then it becomes automatic for us.

You don't need to tell me to NOT kill people anymore because I have it on the hard drive. You don't need to tell me certain things because I'm growing in the knowledge of God and His love and Revelation.

How much is our soul redeemed right now? I don't know. I don't know if the number makes any difference. But let's say it's 20% redeemed. As I bring the revelation from my spirit into my soul, and it goes to the hard drive, I can jump to 21% and then 22% and so on. And there comes a day as we're faithful to do this spiritual work that we see that our souls will grow into that 100%, where our spirit already is.



When our souls come into agreement with the condition with my spirit, then we see that we're just doing the right thing automatically.

Here's the deal. It's important to see this distinction because I am a spirit and I have a soul. I am not a soul. I **have** a soul. Who I really am is a new creation.

Paul wrote in Romans 8:33, ***“Who shall bring a charge against God’s elect? It is God who justifies.”***

He is saying that no man can charge anything against him. And I'm thinking about Paul's life. And I'm thinking, “Wait a minute, weren't you the one that was responsible for Stephen’s death? And how about persecuting the church?”

Well, if Paul were here today, he would say, “George, no, that wasn't me. You see, that was the old Saul. I am now Paul. I am a new creation in Christ Jesus. I didn't do that. I am completely exonerated by the blood of the Lamb. He's forgiven me.

And my Father looks at me now and sees Himself, His Son, Jesus and the Holy Spirit in me.

I am 100% redeemed in my spirit, by the blood of the Lamb.”

ACT 6

I AM MY BELOVED'S AND HE IS MINE

“For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.” Second Corinthians 5:21



Today, in my spirit man, I stand 100% redeemed. This is important to truly grasp because if I can see this picture, that I am a spirit and I have a soul, shame goes away. Most of us believe that my soul is who I am, not that I have a soul and I am a spirit. Shame doesn't say, "I made a mistake." Shame says, "I am a mistake." When we see that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are living in our spirit, we see our spirit as fully redeemed, 100% sanctified. If who I am, a 100% redeemed spirit, there is no way, I am a mistake. That is my new identity, I am a new creation!

“For we have the living Word of God, which is full of energy, and it pierces more sharply than a two-edged sword. It will even penetrate to the very core of our being where soul and spirit, bone and marrow meet! It interprets and reveals the true thoughts and secret motives of our hearts.” Hebrews 4:12 TPT

You see, my bad behavior doesn't define me anymore. I am who my Father says I am, regardless of my behavior.



The Apostle Paul never called anybody that was born again a sinner. He called them a saint. The common misbelief after a person is born again is that “I a sinner saved by grace.” Not anymore. Now I’m a saint that sometimes sins. Big difference.

Many of us are walking around with that identity of a sinner even though we made Jesus the Lord of our lives, and we're 100% redeemed. We still think we're sinners because we don't have this revelation, that I am a spirit, I have a soul.

My soul is in process. It's on the way to full redemption (sanctification). And I live in an my physical body. Remember the Apostle Paul said that “sin dwells in my soul”. See Romans 7:18 Sin does not dwell in my born again spirit. I am a new creation.

Our Father loves us. He wants us to receive His love, and to grow up as a beloved son or beloved daughter, so that we will be the light in the world. The world is so desperately seeking the light. The Light brings solution, remedy to a dark world.

I must understand and believe who He says I am. Then the scripture will be fulfilled:

“Arise, shine; For your light has come! And the glory of the Lord is risen upon you. For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, And deep darkness the people; but the Lord will arise over you. And His glory will be seen upon you. The Gentiles shall come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising.”

Isaiah 60:1-3



We've been stuck with the gospel of salvation all these many years.

As some of us older preachers have been preaching on, you get saved and get your family and friends saved.

But then what?

Somebody please tell me what happens after salvation.

Because we haven't been told, because we haven't discovered that God has a divine destiny for us, we haven't been doing much for God and fulfilling His purposes in the earth.

Well...Jesus never preached the gospel of salvation.

All right, all right, don't send any letters.

Jesus preached the gospel of the kingdom.



Now salvation is the front door to the Kingdom.

And as we come in the front door, we should be finding out who my King is, what his “dom” is. And then hold His hand as He begins to walk me through the kingdom, and tell me who I am. And step into all the good works He's prepared for me before the foundation of the world. See Ephesians 2:10

There you go, folks, that's my that's my story.

That's the change in the last year and a half that's happened as I begin to understand the “holy hug” and to experience the Father's love in a new way, a new dimension.

I think the church in general, has thrown the baby out with the bathwater regarding the emotions and feeling the love of God.

I think He's pouring His love out all over the world right now.

Not just in our area, but there are happenings all over the world of the Father's love. It's the Father's love brings salvation and transformation of the Body of Christ. It's the Father's love brings deliverance, healing, provision, vision, wisdom, and identity. This is the hour of our Father’s love being poured out. His love is the new wine that is been saved for this hour!

ACT 7

TURNING THE HEARTS OF THE FATHERS

A group of businessmen got together to study.

‘What is the greatest problem in the world?’.

After deep deliberation, they came back with their results. It wasn’t war, hunger, poverty or global warming.

It was **fatherlessness!**

With all their statistics of crime, abuse, incarceration, homelessness, mental health, fatherlessness was their number one conclusion or the world’s greatest problem.

Fatherlessness in the USA:

- 90% of inmates are men & at least 75% of them are from fatherless homes.
- 80% of rapists are from fatherless homes.
- 63% of suicide victims are from fatherless homes.
- 90% of homeless and runaway children are from fatherless homes.
- 85% of children with behavior disorders are from fatherless homes.
- 70% of high school dropouts are from fatherless homes.
- 88% of aborted babies are from fatherless homes.

Today we need the revelation that Jesus has restored us to the Father.

Regardless of our earthly father, good, bad or indifferent, today we have our heavenly Father that wants us to know and to feel His great love for us.

We don’t have to live like orphans anymore! We have a spiritual Father.

What the first Adam lost, the second Adam has restored.

Jesus came to reveal the Father and to return us back to the Garden. Our Father is your Beloved. And his banner over you is love. See Solomon 2:4

So, let's pursue Him, to know His love so we can receive it and pour it out, back on Him and on our sphere of influence.

“The Lord your God in your midst, The Might One, will save, He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing.” Zephaniah 3:17
